Baltusrol Golf Club

Baltusrol Golf Club, synonymous with championship golf, sits at the base of Baltusrol Mountain in northern New Jersey, only a stone's throw from New York City. With a rich heritage that dates back to 1895, Baltusrol is considered one of the country's premier golf clubs. Its two championship courses, the Lower and Upper, have played distinguished roles on the national stage since their creation by Golden Age architect A.W. Tillinghast in 1922. Together, the courses have hosted 17 major championships, including seven U.S. Opens and two PGA Championships. The lower course is home to the 2023 KPMG Women's Championship and 2029 PGA Championship.

Leslie C. Quick III

Mr. Quick founded Simon Quick in 2004. He began his career in 1975 as the fourth employee of Quick and Reilly Inc., the first New York Stock Exchange (NYSE) member to offer discount stock brokerage to the investing public. During his 28 years with the firm, he served in many capacities. He was a key member of the management team that built the branch network, started and grew a major clearing firm, acquired and ran a major NASDAQ market making firm, made many acquisitions of NYSE specialist firms and built one of the industry's first electronic internet trading platforms. Mr. Quick was the company liaison for Quick and Reilly in 1983 when it offered stock to the public and became listed on the NYSE. Mr. Quick completed his tenure as Chairman of Fleet Securities, Inc. in 2003 after Fleet Bank had acquired Quick and Reilly Group, Inc. in 1998.

Mr. Quick has served on many industry boards and committees, including the NYSE Hearing Board, the Board of Governors of the Chicago Stock Exchange, the Board of Directors of the Securities Industry Association and District Committee #10 of the NASD. Currently, Mr. Quick is Chairman of the board for Big Brothers Big Sisters of Hudson, Essex & Union Counties, he also serves on the boards of the Bishop's Finance Council for the Diocese of Metuchen and the Finance Council for Our Lady of Perpetual Help. He serves on the Investment Committees for the Diocese of Metuchen, St. Mary's Abbey/Delbarton, and the Franciscan Friars of the Holy Name Province. He also served as the Chairman of the Campaign for the Heart at Morristown Memorial Hospital and is a Trustee for the Foundation for Morristown Medical Center. Mr. Quick sits on the Order Friar Minors Finance Committee in Rome, Italy and St. Patrick's Cathedral in New York City. He served on the Board of Trustees for St. Bonaventure University for 25 years and was named a Trustee Emeritus in 2015.

Mr. Quick earned a BBA in Finance from St. Bonaventure University, which awarded him an honorary doctorate degree. He is a recipient of the Ellis Island Medal of Honor and the Flame of Charity's Man of the Year award.

Les Quick and his wife Eileen reside in Bernardsville, New Jersey. They have four grown children.

1 YOUTH

-PGA Jr. League is one of the PGA of America's most successful youth player development programs. In New Jersey, PGA Jr. League presented by RWJBarnabas Health had over 1,300 athletes compete on 90-plus teams under the direction of PGA and LPGA Professionals.

-The NJGF operates one of the nation's most prolific Golf In Schools programs, impacting more than 120,000 children at over 220 schools across NJ.

The program introduces golf to children by providing equipment that allows golf to be learned and played in non-traditional venues, such as a school gymnasium and limited-space outdoor areas.



2 MILITARY

-PGA HOPE, the flagship military program of the NJGF, designed to introduce golf at No Cost to Veterans with disabilities, in order to enhance their physical, mental, social, and emotional well-being. Led by PGA Professionals, PGA HOPE helps Veterans assimilate back into their communities through the social interaction the game of golf provides.

-Inspiration Golf Range, Located on the Campus of the Lyons VA Medical Center, The Inspiration Golf Range serves as the homesite for NJGF programming.
