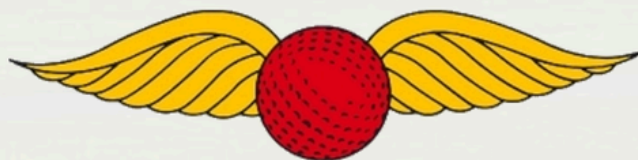

Baltusrol Golf Club, synonymous with championship golf, sits at the base of Baltusrol Mountain in northern New Jersey, only a stone's throw from New York City. With a rich heritage that dates back to 1895, Baltusrol is considered one of the country's premier golf clubs. Its two championship courses, the Lower and Upper, have played distinguished roles on the national stage since their creation by Golden Age architect A.W. Tillinghast in 1922. Together, the courses have hosted 18 major championships, including seven U.S. Opens and two PGA Championships. The lower course is home to the 2029 PGA Championship.

# THREE PILLARS



## 1 YOUTH

-PGA Jr. League is one of the PGA of America's most successful youth player development programs. In New Jersey, PGA Jr. League presented by RWJBarnabas Health had over 1,300 athletes compete on 90-plus teams under the direction of PGA and LPGA Professionals.

-The NJGF operates one of the nation's most prolific Golf In Schools programs, impacting more than 120,000 children at over 220 schools across NJ.

The program introduces golf to children by providing equipment that allows golf to be learned and played in non-traditional venues, such as a school gymnasium and limited-space outdoor areas.



## 2 MILITARY

-PGA HOPE, the flagship military program of the NJGF, designed to introduce golf at No Cost to Veterans with disabilities, in order to enhance their physical, mental, social, and emotional well-being. Led by PGA Professionals, PGA HOPE helps Veterans assimilate back into their communities through the social interaction the game of golf provides.

-Inspiration Golf Range, Located on the Campus of the Lyons VA Medical Center, The Inspiration Golf Range serves as the homesite for NJGF programming.
